This includes 8<sup>th</sup> grade Algebra, 7<sup>th</sup> grade Algebra, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade Pre-Algebra, 6<sup>th</sup> grade Math, and one 5<sup>th</sup> grade Math class. Students will learn foundational mathematics skills that will be essential throughout their future careers in math.

### Materials needed daily:

- Textbook/Student Companion

- Students will be informed of any other material required for that day (e.g. protractors, calculators, etc.)

### Homework:

Homework will typically be assigned 3-5 nights per week. For questions concerning homework, students may reference their resources such as their textbook (algebra), *Digits Homework Helper* (5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and pre-algebra), and online materials by logging onto their Pearson account. I am also more than happy to answer questions regarding homework before/ during/ after school.

### Late Work

Homework will be collected in class on the day that it is due - anything else will be considered late. 10% will be taken off each day that an assignment is late, per school policy. Late work will only be accepted after I receive a yellow slip with a reason why the assignment is late. These can be found in the yellow folder on the chalkboard.

### Exit Slips

Each week students will receive an exit slip before the end of class. This is a way for me to check in on how they are feeling about a subject. Students will then rate themselves on how comfortable they feel on a scale from 1-4 and place it in the corresponding folder.

chapter and why. This is only for  
chapter tests and excludes  
quizzes.
